COVID -19 SAFETY PROTOCOL IMPLEMENTED AT TYLER PARK CENTER FOR THE ARTS AND EARTH CENTER POTTERY:

In response to the current health and safety crises and as TPCA and ECP continue to offer in person workshops, classes and camps, CDC Guidelines are being followed including the following:

- **Masks must be worn by instructors and students at all times inside the buildings**
Masks must be worn so as to cover nose and chin at all times. Gators are not acceptable.

One exception: Artistic mediums necessitating the use of open flame do not allow for mask wearing. Social distancing, air flow and the natural cleansing qualities of fire in lieu of masks in instances where masks could prove dangerous to the wearer. This only applies to flame worked glass workshops

- Social distancing practices are in place at all times
- Hand sanitizing and washing is encouraged upon entry of the art center and during classes and workshops
- Temperature must be taken using our hands-free thermometer upon entering the building and recorded in the log.
- Classes, Workshops and Camps are limited to 10 participants, with August Summer camps allowing for up to 2 separate groups of 8 participants
- Tyler Park Center for the Arts is thrilled to announce Crafts in the Meadow 2021 will be held on October 16 and 17th. We have high hopes that the trajectory of the pandemic continues to move in the direction of safer gatherings mitigated by responsible social behaviors and vaccination. The layout of Crafts in the Meadow lends itself to social distancing with wide pathways and an abundance of open outdoor space. Additionally, the indoor barn space has excellent air flow and also allows for social distancing.

Everyone at the show will be required to adhere to CDC guidelines. There will be hand-sanitizing stations, more hand-washing stations, safe social-distancing signage, and assistance from state park rangers to monitor compliance with CDC recommendations

- Any instructor, artist, or participant who is experiencing any possible Covid-19 Symptoms is asked not to attend or to leave if already in attendance
- Regular cleaning of the art center and restrooms will continue.
- Only instructors, staff, and participants are allowed into the building. The general public may not enter the buildings until more of the population is inoculated.
